Plan Details

Individual Medica Advantage Solution (PPO) is offered through six plans that vary by coverage level and service area:

- Medica Advantage Solution (PPO) H8889-001 and 003, which have no copayments for primary care doctor office visits and cost-sharing for some services, are available in the 7-county Twin Cities metro area.
- Medica Advantage Solution (PPO) H8889-002, which has no copayments for primary care doctor office visits and cost-sharing for some services, is available in the 6-county area surrounding the Twin Cities metro area. Effective 1/1/21: Medica Advantage Solution (PPO) H8889-002 is available in 24 counties of Greater Minnesota.
- Medica Advantage Solution (PPO) H8889-004, which has no copayments for primary care doctor office visits and cost-sharing for some services, is available in 16 counties of southeast Minnesota.
- Medica Advantage Solution with CHI Health (PPO), which has no copayments for primary care doctor office visits and cost-sharing for some services, is available in the 11-county Omaha/Council Bluffs

metro area. Effective 1/1/21: the plan name is changing from Medica Advantage Solution with CHI Health (PPO) to Medica Advantage Solution H3632-001 (PPO).

- Effective 1/1/21: Medica Advantage Solution H8889-005 (PPO), which has coinsurance and copayments for some services available in the 7-county Twin Cities metro area.
- Members do not have the option to purchase optional riders. Part D benefits are included.

Employer Group (EGHP) retiree Medicare Advantaged (PPO) plans are sold to employers offering retiree health benefits. Look for the CMS contract ID in the lower right corner on the front of the member's ID card. The notation will be CMS: H8889-801. Plans vary by coverage level:

- These members have out-of-network coverage similar to their in-network coverage when services are received by a provider who accepts Medicare.
- Plans with supplemental hearing aid coverage reimburse members up to a certain dollar limit. Members of group retiree Medicare Advantage (PPO) plan can purchase hearing aids from any supplier. They are not required to use EPIC Hearing.

Primary Health System (PHS)

Effective 1/1/21: Members enrolled in this plan may select a Primary Health System (PHS) from which to receive care. A PHS is a group of network doctors and health care professionals who can help manage a member's total health, from getting needed preventive screenings and care to coordinating care for multiple health conditions. Members may still get care from other in-network doctors and health care professionals at no additional cost and do not need a referral for covered services.

The member's PHS is identified on their Medica ID card just below their name.
